### TWG2022 Super-4 Qualification Event Criteria & Fees

























#### **Event Overview**

This event series is offered exclusively to IFMA Member NFs with competitive Elite Level athletes in one or more of The World Games Divisions:

F48, F51, F54, F57, F60, F63.5, M57, M63.5, 67, M71, M81, M91

Event will be done in a Super 4 format -4 athletes fighting for one spot in a single event rules format:

Equipment – Gloves Only Rounds & Times – 3 rounds x 3 minutes w/ 1 minute rest

Athletes that qualify will earn a direct spot to compete at TWG2022 in Birmingham Alabama USA. The qualified spot will include full board accommodation & local transport for the athlete (Team Official i.e. coach must be covered by the NF).

Dates are as follows:

Jetlag day: 12.07.2022 (Arrival Day for IF-Passport holders outside of USA)

Arrival day: 13.07.2022 (for IF-Passport holders inside USA)

Training day: 14.07.2022 Start competition: 15.07.2022 End competition: 17.07.2022 Departure date: 18.07.2022

Qualified Athletes will get a feature story on the IFMA & WMC website and social media platforms.

Depending on event date, location and availability – IFMA executive member (Director or ExCo member will attend to present the Qualification Trophy.

Interested hosts will need to confirm delivery of the Event Hosting Criteria.

## Event Host Criteria

- Submission of Event Proposal which should include:
  - o Proposed Event Date between now and 22nd March 2022
  - o Proposed division/s
  - o Proposed event level: National / Continental \*i.e. national would mean you wish to organise a super 4 tournament with 4 of your top national athletes / continental would mean either 1 or 2 national athletes and 2 or 3 top athletes from the region in the case of continental, final athlete selection must be discussed & coordinated with WMC Sports Director Andrew Scott and approved by IFMA. General requirement for selection of athletes is to have a 60 percent win ratio, won last 3 fights etc.



- o Proposed LOV (Look of Venue i.e. branding/lighting/effects etc.)
- o Proposed official host: where athletes, coaches and officials will be accommodated at the cost of the host (full-board)
- o Proposed Covid-19 protocols i.e. PCR testing system/accommodation & transit bubble etc.
- o Proposed media plan: production, media partners, streaming etc.
- Technical/FOP:
  - o Regional Qualifier: 3 x IFMA ITOs on site to oversee competition & technical aspects (flights, accommodation & per diem of \$70 USD per day)
  - o National Qualifier: 1 x IFMA ITO on site to oversee competition & technical aspects (flights, accommodation & per diem of \$70 USD per day)
  - o Use of IFMA approved equipment (FBT/MTG/Wesing/Dragon)
  - o Medical Services (weigh-in, ringside, emergency etc.)
- Anti-Doping: Minimum 1 doping test per 4 athletes
- Broadcasting: Production plan / Media Channels / Live Stream etc.
- Sanctioning Fee:
  - o Base fee: 3,000 USD per qualification for Continental Level 4,000 USD per qualification for Regional Level

\*\*discount will be discussed and applied for those wishing to do 2 or more divisions in one event, i.e. hosting a Continental level to qualify 2 athletes in 2 divisions will be charged 5,000 USD reduced from 6,000 USD.
